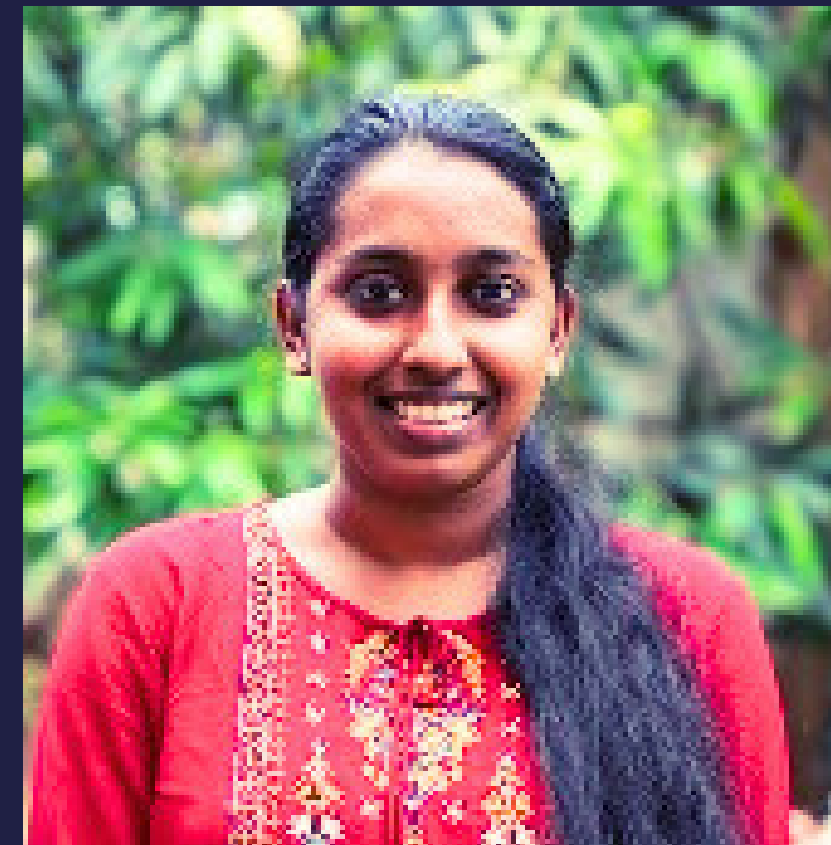
# Scholarship Success



My name is Veena Mahor and I am pursuing a M.A. Public Policy and Governance Programme at CVV. Without the CVV scholarship it would have been very challenging for me to pursue my aspiration of advanced studies. Due to it I have successfully completed the first year of the MA-PPG course and have entered my second year.

The experience has been excellent. I have been able to gain professional knowledge, tools, and techniques on key aspects of Public Policy and Governance. CVV has also provided opportunity for experiential learning wherein we investigated the legislative design and implications of the three Farm Acts and submitted the report to the Supreme Court.

We also undertook a research study in context to COVID-19 to understand the affordability and accessibility of health care at private hospitals during the pandemic in India, and we plan to publish the report in a short span. The exposure and skills to delve into real time information and data management has helped me hone my policy analysis skills.



My name is Niranjana Shyju, I'm a 1st year B. Com ACCA student at CVV. I am opting for a scholarship because it will be a great aid for my studies as my family is not very stable in terms of financial conditions. My father is a driver, and my mother is a housewife so the primary source of funding for me and my sister's education is my father's income, which is not at all sufficient to meet all these expenses.

In such a situation, I have taken this integrated course, which is one of the leading professions in the world, it is one such profession which will help me achieve my goal and make my family secure.

Through this scholarship support I can fulfil my dreams of getting a proper and safe career ahead and complete my education. Thus, after a few years I can contribute something to my family and to the society.



# Scholarship Success

I chose to enrol in CVV's B.Sc. Psychology programme because of my deep interest in learning about traditional Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS). The integration of Indic philosophy in the curriculum offered me a fresh perspective that resonated with my values. It wasn't just about learning terms and concepts—it was about understanding the core of Indian philosophy and how it enriches our knowledge of human psychology.

One of the most rewarding aspects of my time at CVV has been participating in various IKS projects. These include studying how Vedanta can reduce stress in youth and comparing mental health challenges across generations. I also contributed to a government-funded AICTE IKS project, focusing on how the Bhagavad Gita helps young adults overcome distractions.

Currently, my research focuses on emotional expression and regulation in adult men in India, and the need for long-term psychological intervention to reduce crime rates among children in conflict with the law in Kerala.

These experiences have deepened my understanding of psychology and shown me how ancient Indian wisdom can help address modern psychological challenges. They have also inspired me to pursue an M.Sc. in Clinical Psychology at CVV, continuing my journey in this supportive community.

Looking ahead, my goal is to become a clinical psychologist and researcher. I aim to apply evidence-based research and interventions, combined with insights from IKS, to foster resilience and improve mental health in communities.
